

CHAMPIONS LEADING SUPPORT GROUPS

Indicator Phrasing

INDICATOR PHRASING: number of survivor champions having in the course of the project actively led a support group.

What is its purpose?

The indicator measures the number of “survivor champions” that have in the course of the project lead a minimum number of sessions with other survivors of violence. Survivor champions are people who experienced violence, overcame its consequences and started helping other people who had a similar experience.

How to Collect and Analyse the Required Data

Determine the indicator's value by using the following methodology:

1) **Define how many times** a survivor champion needs to lead a support group in order to be considered as “actively leading” the group.

2) **Collect the required data** using one of the following approaches:

Using existing documentation: If there is documentation showing how many sessions were led by each survivor champion (e.g. attendance sheets, project's M&E data), use it to count how many champions lead a group for at least the number of times defined in point 1 above.

Using representative survey: If there is no relevant documentation, conduct interviews with a [representative sample](#) of champions, asking them 1) whether and 2) how many times they led a support group in the course of the project.

3) **The indicator's value** equals to the number of survivor champions who led a support group for the minimum number of times.
