

ACCESS TO NON-FOOD ITEMS (NFIS)

Indicator Phrasing

INDICATOR PHRASING: number of households receiving NFIs in accordance with the relevant Cluster's standards (if available)

What is its purpose?

The indicator measures the number of households receiving kits with non-food items (NFI) in line with the Cluster's recommendations. It should always be complemented with an indicator assessing beneficiaries' satisfaction with the provided NFIs.

How to Collect and Analyse the Required Data

Determine the indicator's value by using the following methodology:

- 1) **Review project reports and distribution lists** (signed by beneficiaries) to identify the number of households which received NFIs.
- 2) **Verify the data** by reviewing the results of post-distribution monitoring (e.g. on the % of beneficiaries who reported receiving the provided items). If required, adjust the number of people who received NFIs. If the post-distribution data is not available, it is recommended that you interview a representative sample of people who were reported to receive NFI.
- 3) **Identify whether the NFIs were in line with the Cluster's standards.** This should be done by comparing the Cluster's official recommendations with the content of provided NFI kits.
- 4) **The indicator's value** equals to the number of people for whom it was confirmed that they received the NFIs and that this assistance was in line with the Cluster's standards recommendations.
