Indicator Phrasing

INDICATOR PHRASING: The percentage of people that have taken part in leadership projects that within 1 year are actively engaged in positions of influence or decision making within their communities or wider

What is its purpose?

To assess whether the leadership training that people have been doing supports people into positions of influence and leadership

How to Collect and Analyse the Required Data

A follow up survey (can be by phone, instant message or email) of participants in a leadership project one year after the project closes to see how they have put their training to use. Where alumni/graduates are being tracked and supported on an ongoing basis this can be done as part of regular catch up.

Actively engaged implies any of:

- speaking out publicly, organising or campaigning on social, political, environmental or economic issues
- taking up positions of leadership within their communities or wider in order to make a positive contribution to their society
